Bibliographic Records and Access

All copies of Northern Illinois University theses, dissertations, qualifying papers, and certificate of advanced studies papers are cataloged in OCLC and searchable in the Illinet Online (IO) and OCLC.

The circulating copy of Northern Illinois University theses, dissertations, qualifying papers, or certificate of advanced study papers can be loaned to those borrower groups as stipulated in the university libraries circulation policy (049). Any copies housed in the university archives are non-circulating.

Duplication

As specified in the university's *Academic Policies and Procedures Manual*, the university libraries policy as pertains to the duplication of NIU certificate of advanced studies papers, theses, dissertations, and qualifying papers deposited in the university libraries is as follows:

Individuals requesting copies of dissertations which are available from University Microforms International (UMI) Dissertation Services, Ann Arbor, Michigan should order them directly from UMI. Users may order dissertations online through Dissertation Abstracts at a reduced price. Northern Illinois University has been a UMI participating institution since 1964.

Non-circulating CAS papers, dissertations, theses, and qualifying papers which are part of the University Archives collections may be copied only to provide replacement copies for the University Libraries circulating dissertation and thesis collections, or if the authors of a dissertation cannot obtain a copy of their work through other sources.

NIU Libraries houses a circulating Northern Illinois University Dissertation and Thesis Collection in Founders Memorial Library (or one of the branch libraries). All copyrighted materials contained in these collections are subject to copying restrictions as specified under U.S. copyright laws. Individuals may make copies of these materials as long as they are in compliance with these laws.

Dissertations and theses which are not copyrighted are stamped as follows by the Graduate School:

Any use of material contained herein must be duly acknowledged. The author's permission must be obtained if any portion is to be published or included in publication.

Number of Copies to be retained

Normally, the university libraries will retain two copies of any Northern Illinois University theses, dissertations, qualifying papers, and certificate of advanced studies papers added to its collections. One copy is non-circulating and housed in the university archives. One copy is circulating and housed either in Founders Memorial Library or one of the branch libraries.
