## INTRODUCTION

The University Archives acquired the Presidents' papers in numerous installments beginning in the mid-1960's. With the exception of files relating to legal counsel and personnel matters, there are no restrictions on access to the records through the Monat administration. Researchers must secure permission to publish any of the materials in these records from the NIU Legal Counsel Office.

## SCOPE AND CONTENT

The Presidents' Papers begin with Northern's constitution and by-laws followed by a description and historical sketch of the university's administrative organization and codification of policies. The remaining records are divided into eleven records subgroups. Only one president, J. Clifton Brown (1927-1929), is not represented. Records from the later years of President John La Tourette's administration and those from President John Peters are not yet open to researchers.

Subgroup one documents John Williston Cook's presidency (1899-1919). Most of the records detail Cook's administration at Northern and the Illinois State Normal School. Of special note is the series on the Andrew Brown Estate; Brown willed money from his estate to Northern for student scholarships. Also included are personal papers, family and business correspondence (1862-1922), biographical and genealogical data, photographs, publications, and scrapbooks. In addition, there are several mimeographed articles by John Dewey (1896-1988). Researchers may wish to consult the faculty papers of Charles A. McMurry for information related to the Dewey materials.

The second and smallest subgroup contains the administrative correspondence of J. Stanley Brown (1920-1926). To date, these are the only available records of his administration.

Subgroup three contains Karl L. Adams' records (1929-1949). Series I comprises his administrative correspondence arranged alphabetically by subject. The reports and educational records in this series provide an insight into the workings of a small teacher's college. Personal papers including biographical data, photographs, and correspondence complete the Adams Papers.

President Leslie Holmes' papers comprise subgroup four (1938-1967). The subgroup begins with correspondence and information pertaining to the monthly Teachers College Board meetings. Series II contains all of Holmes' administrative correspondence arranged alphabetically. Of special note is the correspondence on the first Montgomery Arboretum Controversy (1955-1959) and on an outdoor education program at the Loreda Taft Campus

(1949-1952). Also included are commencement addresses, reports, publications, and personal papers.

Subgroup five documents Rhoten Smith's presidency (1967-1971) and is divided into five series. The first and largest series comprises the administrative correspondence. Researchers studying student unrest in the late 1960's may wish to consult the military science and police science files. Smith's decision on the second Montgomery Arboretum Controversy and the activities in response to his decision also are documented in the papers. Series IV contains numerous education legislative bills which indicate problems faced by educational institutions at this time. The final series documents Smith's inauguration.

The papers in the sixth subgroup document Richard Nelson's term as president (1971-1978). The administrative files are arranged alphabetically by subject and include correspondence, memoranda, reports, bulletins, and news releases. [Researchers should note, however, that there are some subject files from the Nelson years located in subgroup ten.] The administrative files series deals primarily with administrative and academic divisions on campus and contains statistical data on enrollment, financial evaluations, facilities management, and institutional studies. Perhaps the most interesting records document Nelson's request to ban the national anthem from being played at basketball games due to racial unrest (1971-1972). The subgroup contains little biographical history on Nelson's earlier careers in law and industry.

William R. Monat's correspondence, speeches, and cabinet minutes may be found in subgroup seven. There are four correspondence series beginning with file copies of every letter sent in chronological order from 1978 through 1984. The other three correspondence series include Monat's personal letters, communications with various state education agencies, and the correspondence from and to academic units on campus. The introduction of the personal computer coupled with the proliferation of copy machines in the 1980's caused an explosion in volume of the records generated by and sent to the president's office. This increase in volume coupled with a relatively rapid turnover in the office (four presidents in less than ten years) precludes identifying a set of subject files for the Monat administration. All subject files from the president's office from the mid-1970's forward may be found below in subgroup ten, "President's Office Subject Files."

Subgroup eight records document the brief (ten month) tenure of Clyde Wingfield as president. Inauguration planning records and administrative correspondence comprise the bulk of these files and any other documents would be found below in subgroups ten or eleven.

John E. La Tourette's papers may be found in subgroup nine. This subgroup includes papers from his year as acting president (1984-1985) and from his term as president (1986-2000). Since Professor La Tourette served as NIU vice-president for academic affairs and provost (1979-1984) researchers should also consult the Provost Office Records held in the University Archives. Records from the current administration of John Peters are not open to researchers.

Subgroups ten and eleven provide important records documenting more than one president's administration. Subgroup ten is the largest of all records subgroups, the President's Office Subject Files, with the bulk of these documents dating from 1970 forward. There are several "a-z" container listings but comprehensive alphabetical subject access to all records listed in this inventory is provided in the index at the end. These subject files provide a rich, broad source for the university's history over the past twenty years as they contain incoming correspondence from on and off campus, copies of outgoing memos and letters, reports and studies on hundreds of topics, and NIU accreditation and professional affiliation documents. This subgroup is a mini-archives for the entire university from the point of view of the president's office. Also included here are materials from Anne Kaplan, Executive Assistant to the President (1986-1993), and from Curtiss Behrens, Assistant to the President (1986-1989). Since 1899 each president has reported regularly to the university's governing board and these reports are found in subgroup eleven, "President's Report to the Board of Regents." B.O.R. reports include information on all faculty personnel transactions, campus and building development, all major purchases, and on the grants and contracts in which the university participates. [Note: as of 1996 the President's Report is included in the bound Board of Trustees Minutes, beginning with Box 18A in UA 3].

Researchers should note that other records within the University Archives may relate in whole or part to specific topics represented in these records. For further information consult a reference person or the University Archives inventories. The Audio-Visual Collection contains photographs of each president as well as tape recorded addresses from some.

HISTORICAL SKETCH  
John Williston Cook

John Williston Cook was born April 20, 1844 in Oneida County, New York. At the age of seven he came with his family to Illinois to settle on a farm in McLean County. Graduating from the Illinois State Normal School in 1865, Cook accepted a position as principal of schools in Brimfield, Peoria County, Illinois. After one year at Brimfield, Cook returned to his alma mater to become a member of the faculty. On August 26, 1867 he married Lydia Spofford; the couple had two children, John Loring and Agnes Spofford.

Over a period of thirty-three years, Cook became a recognized leader in what was known as the "normal school movement". At Illinois State Normal School Cook taught geography, history, and reading, chaired the mathematics department for fourteen years, and ascended to the presidency of I.S.N.S. in 1890. Tempted by opportunities offered at the newly established normal school in DeKalb, Cook resigned from his position in 1899 and accepted the presidency at Northern Illinois State Normal School.

Cook's twenty years of service at Northern brought about several changes and improvements on campus. An eminent educator and administrator, Cook organized the structure of the school, hired the faculty, established a two year curriculum, and secured the training method for teachers based on the educational philosophy of Charles A. McMurry.

Cook's achievements were not confined to the administration of two growing institutions. Cook edited the "Illinois Schoolmaster" from 1874 to 1876 and the "Illinois School Journal" from 1883 to 1886. He also co-authored, with Nebraska Cropsey, Normal Course in Number (1892), wrote the History of Education in Illinois (1912), and contributed a number of articles on education to school periodicals. Aside from writing Cook was an active member of the National Education Association (president, 1904-1905) and Illinois State Teacher's Association (president, 1880).

Resigning from the presidency of Northern Illinois State Normal School in 1919, Cook continued to serve on the faculty until his death on July 15, 1922.

HISTORICAL SKETCH

J. Stanley Brown

J. Stanley Brown was born near Cumberland, Ohio on September 13, 1863. At seventeen he became a village school master, a position he held for three years. In 1883 he entered Denison University and after six years graduated with an A.B. degree in classical languages. Brown's several academic positions included: a classics instructor in Kentucky; president of Arlington College (Kentucky); principal of a normal school in Dalles, Oregon; and principal of Joliet Township School. In 1919 Brown accepted the position of president of the Northern Illinois State Normal School.

During his administration Brown promoted the use of public relations to boost school spirit and expand programs. He formed the President's Council consisting of five senior (male) professors and the Committee on Athletics to actively involve faculty members in the school's operations. Brown also contributed to the community. He taught Sunday School classes and served as a member of the Board of Education of the Northern Baptist Convention from 1919 to 1935. He frequently spoke out against liquor interests and following the war, traveled to various Illinois cities to speak on labor unrest.

J. Stanley Brown offered his resignation in 1927 following a great deal of controversy over his financial dealings and his administrative capabilities.

HISTORICAL SKETCH  
Karl Langdon Adams

Karl Langdon Adams was born in Lexington, Ohio on September 5, 1888. He received his Bachelor of Science degree from Ohio University in 1909 and his master of arts degree from the Columbia University Teacher's College in 1929. From 1910 to 1928 Adams held the following positions in teaching and administration: science teacher and athletic coach, Sidney High School, Sidney, Ohio; Assistant Principal, Moline High School, Moline Illinois; Professor of Science, State Teacher's College, St. Cloud, Minnesota; Assistant Professor of Education, Teacher's College, Columbia University, New York. While working in St. Cloud and at Columbia, Adams began to confine his educational interest to teacher training and in 1928 he assumed the presidency at Northern Illinois State Teacher's College with a strong conviction to improve teacher education in Illinois.

During his administration, Adams played an important role in the educational transformation of the state teacher's college. In 1941, Adams established a Faculty Administrative Council to discuss college matters, make recommendations, and suggest changes on campus. In 1943, as Chairman of the Teacher Training Committee of the Illinois Education Association, Adams was responsible for raising the certification requirements in the State of Illinois to the four year level. He also served as Consultant to the Educational Policies Commission, Committee member of the American Association of Teacher's Colleges, Advisory Committee member of the Progressive Education Association, and Advisory Council member of the Illinois Adult Education Association.

Karl Adams died in office on September 5, 1948. Through his efforts, Adams promoted higher standards for teacher education. The Faculty Club recognized his distinguished career by establishing "The Karl Langdon Adams Foundation." Later, the University named the new women's dormitory in his honor.

HISTORICAL SKETCH  
Leslie A. Holmes

Born in Freeport, Illinois, Leslie Holmes earned his B.S., M.S., and Ph.D. degrees from the University of Illinois. Between 1928 and 1931 Holmes received teaching and travel research fellowships from the University and directed geological research in the southwest for the Skelly and Texas Oil companies. During the Depression he became a geography and geology teacher at a community high school in Chicago, Illinois. In 1936 Holmes left Chicago to join the geography staff at the Illinois State University in Normal and in 1943 became assistant to the president. Six years later the Northern Illinois State Teachers College in DeKalb appointed Holmes its fifth president.

During Holmes' term as president, Northern experienced phenomenal physical growth and developed several new administrative and academic programs. Student enrollment soared as land acquisitions and building construction increased. The introduction of advanced degrees at the masters and doctoral levels promoted Northern to university status in 1957. Northern also acquired the Lorado Taft Campus in 1951, a sixty acre tract of land in Oregon, Illinois, to increase the size and scope of the Outdoor Education Department. In a period of eighteen years the Holmes Administration provided first rate educational facilities for Northern's students.

Leslie A. Holmes retired from the presidency at NIU on August 31, 1967; he became a visiting professor at Arizona State University. Holmes died in Tempe, Arizona on August 21, 1974.

HISTORICAL SKETCH  
Rhoten A. Smith

Rhoten A. Smith was born in Dallas, Texas on January 17, 1921. He attended Texas Wesleyan College and the University of Texas (1940-1942) and graduated with a bachelor's degree from the University of Kansas (1946). Continuing his education, Smith received a master's degree from the University of Kansas (1948) and a doctorate in philosophy from the University of California, Berkeley (1954).

From 1951 to 1968 Smith served on the faculties of Kansas, New York, and Temple Universities. He held the following positions: Instructor, Assistant, and Associate Professor of Political Science, University of Kansas (1951-1957); Professor of Political Science, New York University (1958-1961); Dean of the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences, Temple University, Philadelphia (1961-1968).

For four years Smith augmented his extensive teaching and research activities by working for the Citizenship Clearing House, a privately funded national organization devoted to promoting the active participation of college trained people in the political process. Serving this group as associate director (1955-1956) and director (1958-1961), Smith participated in its research programs and in its various projects aimed at students, teachers, and political organizations.

Smith also served as consultant to various governmental and political organizations. He acted as Research Associate for the Government Research Center, University of Kansas, 1946-1948; Research Consultant to the Kansas Legislative Council, Advisor to the Chairman of the Kansas Democratic Party, 1959-1960; Consultant to the Kansas Constitutional Revision Commission, 1957-1958; Chief Consultant to the Political Education Program for the Maurice and Laura Falk Foundation in Pittsburgh, 1958; Consultant to the Executive Development Program for the Ford Foundation, 1960; and Advisor to the Commission on General Education of New York Community College, 1960-1961.

In 1967 Rhoten A. Smith accepted the appointment as President of Northern Illinois University. Smith's experience in both public and private universities enabled him to understand the basic rights, privileges, and responsibilities of the students and faculty members. Faced with student disruptions and a state-wide budget freeze on building construction, Smith still made several major contributions to NIU during his brief (three years) tenure as President. He established a rapport with students, initiated campus programs to promote racial justice on campus, and improved university relations with the DeKalb community and surrounding areas. In 1971 President Smith resigned to accept the chief academic post at the University of Pittsburgh. Rhoten Smith and his wife retired to Greeley, Colorado, where he died on September 6, 2003.

HISTORICAL SKETCH  
Richard J. Nelson

Born on November 15, 1915 Richard Nelson attended public schools in his native Chicago and worked as a bank clerk before entering the University of Illinois. Shortly after graduation in 1940, Nelson enlisted in the First Infantry Division serving in North Africa and Europe. He returned to school and earned a doctor of laws degree from Northwestern University in 1948.

From 1949 to 1952 Nelson worked in top level positions for the State of Illinois. After serving as Assistant State's Attorney, General and Administrative Assistant to Governor Adlai E. Stevenson, he joined a Chicago based firm, the Inland Steel Company in 1953. There Nelson spent most of his professional career working as an executive in the industrial relations and personnel administration divisions. He held the following positions: Manager of Labor Relations, 1959-1965; Director of Public Relations, 1965-1968; Assistant Vice-President for Public Affairs, 1968-1971.

Aside from administrative duties at the Inland Steel Company, Nelson was Vice Chairman of the Illinois Board of Higher Education and participant in the completion of the first two phases of the Illinois Master Plan for Higher Education. He also was named to the Board of Governors of State Colleges and Universities and served as chairman from 1967 to 1968.

In 1971 Nelson became President of Northern Illinois University. His major task was to eliminate problems created by enrollment decline and budgetary restrictions. He met these problems through reorganizing administrative units and instructional positions, encouraging off-campus programs to link Northern more vitally to its constituents, and initiating attempts to win support for Northern in the state legislature. Having contributed to the educational, political, and civic related activities on campus, President Nelson resigned from his position in 1978. He retired to Evanston, and died there May 13, 1994. Richard J. Nelson's papers regarding the Illinois Committee for Fair Employment Practices, 1959-1966, are held by the Illinois Historical Survey at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign. HISTORICAL SKETCH  
William R. Monat

William R. Monat, Northern Illinois University's eighth president, was born October 8, 1924 in Virginia, Minnesota. After graduating from Virginia High School in 1942, he served in the U.S. Army until 1945. Monat received both his B.A. (1949) and Ph.D. (1956) in political science from the University of Minnesota. He taught in the Political Science Department of Wayne State University from 1954-1957.

From 1957-1960 Monat served as an executive assistant to then Governor Millikin of Michigan. He returned to teaching as a professor of political science at Pennsylvania State University (1960-1968). He served one year as director of the budget for the Pennsylvania State Legislature (1968-1969).

Monat was employed by Northern Illinois University as chair of the Political Science Department from 1969-1971. He left Illinois in 1971 to work at Bernard M. Baruch College of the City University of New York. At Baruch, he was dean of faculties (1971-1974) and vice-president of academic affairs (1974-1976). Monat returned to Northern Illinois University to serve two years as vice-president and provost. He became acting president in February 1978 following the resignation of Richard Nelson. Monat was named president in July 1978 and held that office until August, 1984.

During Monat's tenure as president, doctoral programs in education, geology, biological sciences, and mathematical sciences were added at NIU. The College of Law was opened at Northern in 1979. Monat left the presidency of NIU in 1984 to become the first chancellor of the Regency Universities System of Illinois, a post he held until his resignation in August 1986. He is currently retired from Northern Illinois University, and resides in DeKalb, Illinois.

HISTORICAL SKETCH

Clyde J. Wingfield

Northern's ninth president, Clyde J. Wingfield, was born March 13, 1931 in Arkansas. Wingfield earned his B.S. and M.S. degrees in political science from East Texas State University. He earned a Ph.D. in political science from Syracuse University in New York. Wingfield worked as an assistant professor of Political Science at Texas Technological College (1956-1959) and as an assistant professor of Political Science and Public Administration at Pennsylvania State University (1959-1962). He served as director of the public administration graduate program at Northern Illinois University from 1962 to 1964.

Wingfield was employed in a variety of administrative positions over the next 20 years: professor and department head, Political Science, University of Texas at El Paso (1964-1967); executive vice-president, University of Texas at El Paso (1967-1969); director, graduate program in public administration, Southern Methodist University (1969-1971); president, Bernard M. Baruch College, City University of New York (1971-1976); executive vice-president for academic affairs and provost, University of Miami, Coral Gables (1976-1982); and president, State University of New York, College at Old Westbury (1982-1985). Wingfield was named President of Northern Illinois University effective July 1985.

Clyde Wingfield resigned from the Presidency in May 1986. He then served on the faculty of the Political Science Department at Northern Illinois University until his retirement in 1993. Wingfield died at his home in Dallas, Texas on September 15, 2011.

HISTORICAL SKETCH  
John E. La Tourette

John E. La Tourette, Northern's tenth president, was born November 5, 1932 in Perth Amboy, New Jersey. He earned his B.A., M.A., and Ph.D. degrees in economics from Rutgers University in New Brunswick, New Jersey. He taught in the Economics Department of Rutgers from 1958-1961.

La Tourette spent the next thirteen years employed as a professor in the Economics Department of the State University of New York at Binghamton. He served as the chair of the department for five years (1969-1974) and also spent one year as acting provost (1973-1974). La Tourette continued his work in academic administration at Bowling Green State University in Ohio. He held dual positions as the vice-president in charge of research and as dean of the Graduate School from 1974-1979.

La Tourette came to Northern Illinois University in 1979 to become vice-president of academic affairs and provost, a position he held until 1984. When President William Monat resigned in 1984 to become chancellor of the Illinois Regency Universities System, John La Tourette accepted the position of acting president (Sept. 1984-June 1985). He returned to his former position as provost when Clyde Wingfield assumed the presidency in the summer of 1985. Following Wingfield's resignation in May 1986, La Tourette was named President of NIU by the Illinois Board of Regents. President La Tourette and his wife Lili have two children, Marc and Yanique. La Tourette retired in May of 2000, and moved to Prescott, Arizona.

HISTORICAL SKETCH  
John G. Peters

John G. Peters, Northern's eleventh president, is a native of Strongsville, Ohio. He earned his B.A. in political science at Cleveland's John Carroll University and a M.A in government from Ohio University in Athens. In 1974 Peters earned his Ph.D. degrees in political science from the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign.

Peters spent 20 years in teaching and administrative roles at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln. He became associate dean of his college in 1982, served as associate to the chancellor, and in 1988 was named dean of the College of Arts and Sciences at UNL. Next Dr. Peters moved on to the University of Tennessee at Knoxville and became their provost and chief operating officer.

President Peters assumed the presidency of Northern Illinois University in June 2000. He and his wife Barbara have one son, Russell. Peters resigned as president in 2013 and moved to Knoxville, Tennessee.
